Pathologist (Contractor) at the National Institute of Environmental Health Sciences/NIH. Dr. Willson also leads the Division of the NTP Global Training Program in Toxicological Pathology.

Dr. Willson is a member of the International Harmonization of Nomenclature and Diagnostic Criteria (INHAND) working group for the male reproductive system and the Society of Toxicologic Pathology (STP) Scientific and Regulatory Policy Committee Digital Peer Review Working Group. She serves on the Editorial Board of *Toxicologic Pathology* and as Chair of the STP Membership Committee and Chair of the STP Reproductive Pathology Special Interest Group. Dr. Willson has authored or co-authored over 30 publications or book chapters.

She received her veterinary degree at North Carolina State University College of Veterinary Medicine after completing her Ph.D. in Biology at Duke University. She completed a residency in anatomic pathology and an NIH postdoctoral fellowship in comparative reproductive pathology at Wake Forest University School of Medicine.
