Georgette Hill joined Inotiv in 2006. She is responsible for managing both government and commercial pathology projects and generates cost estimates for histopathology services, including routine microscopic evaluations, pathology peer reviews, and pathology working groups (PWGs).

As a toxicologic pathologist, she has organized, coordinated, and conducted close to thirty PWGs for the National Toxicology Program (NTP) for chronic, subchronic, and immunotoxicity rodent studies. She has been the pathology data review, audit of pathology specimens, and quality assessment pathologist for various NTP studies. In addition, Dr. Hill has collaborated with numerous NIEHS/NTP investigators to provide histopathological evaluations for a variety of research studies.
